



Information Needed to Quote RFID

- 1. What are the labels being applied to?**
Will there be metal or liquids in the product?
- 2. What is the ideal and maximum size the label can be finished?**
This will depend on what you are tagging and where the tag will be placed.
- 3. What read distance is required?**
- 4. What face material and adhesive is required?**
- 5. How will you want these RFID labels finished?**
- 6. Will you be printing these labels, or will Repacorp?**
If you are printing the labels, we need to know the printer model.
- 7. How are you going to encode (write data) to your tags?**
Typical methods include using a RFID printer/encoder, a high speed label applicator, a RFID hand-held, or a stationary RFID reader. If you wish, Repacorp can print and encode for you.
- 8. What are the environmental conditions the tag will experience during its' life-cycle?**
Note the temperature, humidity, electrostatic discharge. Will it be washed with water and soap?
- 9. How many tags do you need?**
Forecasting your tag consumption is extremely important to both you and your supplier. By forecasting, you can get volume discounts and delivery of exactly what you need and when you need it. Ideally, each month Repacorp will send you the number of tags you need and charges it to a blanket purchase order.
